The British Horse Loggers Charitable Trust (BHLCT) has earmarked some of its resources to support established or prospective horse loggers in developing their business. The Trust has already funded five apprenticeships but feel that there may be others out there who would welcome targeted support in a particular area. The BHLCT is open to applications for up to £500 (incl. VAT), which should represent a contribution to the overall funding of your proposal.

This funding will only be available to BHL members. Not all applications will be successful, so it is important to make your case for funding as strong as possible.

The sort of thing the Trust will consider could be: training; courses; advice from or a visit by or to an experienced horse logger or forestry professional - but we are open to your ideas. Unfortunately we would not support requests for help with equipment purchases. A short agreement will need to be signed by the recipient of funding.
