The misdemeanour appears in the left hand column, any guidance notes for the judge appears in the middle column and the points and the points to be deducted appear in the right hand column.

Harness deemed unfit for work	The opinion of two judges and the lead judge should be sort	If repairs cannot be effected, team disqualified.		
Inappropriate P.P.E. or no P.P.E. worn	Hard hat. Team not allowed to continue until fault rectified	10 points per item		
Inappropriate load selected	Animal is seen to struggle with the size of load repeatedly.	20 points

Draught animal fails to stand still when told too	At judges discretion	5 points per incident		
Draught animal moves off inappropriately	i.e. False starts, wrong gear (to fast), out of control	5-10 points per incident		
Loss of control of animal		20 points		
Operator positions themselves in a danger zone	i.e. standing on the inside of the a load on a bend, or between wheels while loading a forwarder	5 points per incident		
Damage to standing timber		5 points per incident		
Inaccurate crosscutting	Tolerance of 25mm or one inch of spec either way	5 points per billet		
Poor Stacking	Stacks not straight or safe	10-20 points		
Poor or lack of communication with chainsaw operator	One off judgement	5-30 points		
Injury requiring medical assistance.		50 points
